Also Mr. Ding is a Board member of ZTE Services Deutschland GmbH (Germany), and ZTE Managed Services Southern Europe, S.L. (Spain) on behalf of ZTE Group's shareholder interest.

Between 2014 and the beginning of 2016, and before joining ZTE Corporation, Mr. Ding was a founding member of the investment banking business in Europe for Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (ICBC), the largest bank in China, and was deputy to the head of that business, helped overseeing all investment banking related business (M&A / PE / Acquisition financing, etc.) in 8 European countries for ICBC. In this role he was mainly advising Chinese corporate and governmental clients in their outbound acquisitions / investments into Europe, and helped consummate more than a dozen transactions in the region, including Jinjiang International's \in 1.3bn acquisition of Groupe du Louvre in France, and Fosun International's \in 1.1bn acquisition of Caixa Seguros in Portugal.
